**Charlie has worked hard** in North Manor over the last year talking to residents and listening to your concerns. Charlie has been to Council meetings and asked questions about the issues which are important to you. For example, residents reported worries about speeding traffic, building on greenfield sites, illegal car parking and equal access to local parks, to name a few.

#### PHOTO ID NOW REQUIRED FOR VOTING

For the **local elections on 4<sup>th</sup> May**, voters will need to show **photo ID** to vote at polling stations. The main forms of acceptable ID are:

- UK passport
- Driving licence
- Blue Badge
- Older or Disabled Person's bus pass

If you don't have photo ID, you can apply for a free Voter Authority Certificate. People should now plan ahead and either apply for a postal vote which doesn't require photo ID or apply for the Voter Authority Certificate. Visit <u>www.gov.uk/how-to-vote</u> for more information



## **ROAD SAFETY CONCERNS ACROSS NORTH MANOR**

**Residents in North Manor have been telling Charlie** how worried they are about the speed that some vehicles are travelling on many roads in North Manor. To find out how bad the problem is, Charlie has been out with a speed gun to check traffic speeds within 30 mph zones on Holcombe Road, Bolton Road, Brandlesholme Road and Walmersley Road.

The table and graphs below show the speed of the vehicles that Charlie captured with the speed gun. On all of these roads there are speeding problems – more than half of the vehicles were travelling over 30 mph, with Walmersley Road and Bolton Road being particularly bad.

Charlie has asked the Council about installing traffic calming measures on North Manor roads. Unfortunately, the Council say that until an accident is reported where there has been an injury, funding road safety here is a low priority.


